
# World University Service (WUS) Austria

- Acts as facilitator of cooperation and knowledge transfer between SEE and EU universities









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




#### **Study Program Development Projects**

The Austrian HE institutions can act as

- a) cooperation partners ("loose" partnerships)
- b) twinning partners (more formal and long-term commitment)

#### **Austrian partners should:**

- Share knowledge and experience in study program and curriculum development, including eLearning courses
- Invite course lecturers for study visits
- Conduct majority of peer reviews (course syllabi and scripts)
- Send guest lecturers to partner institution in SEE
- Take over supervision of final theses/projects
- Initiate exchange possibilities for students of both programs

### Brain Gain Program + (BGP+)

(in BiH, Kosovo, Montenegro and Serbia)

(1) BGP+ Classic (1-3 weeks teaching assignment)

(2) BGP+ with extended period of stay (up to 1 semester)

(2a) Teaching and Mentoring

(2b) Teaching, Mentoring and Research
