



UNIMIG Study Visit

Introduction:

The main objective of the study visit is to provide the participants with an insight into the working methods of specialized competence centers being integral parts of an institution of higher education (University). The participants, who in the last consequence will be the responsible for the organization of the Migration Competence Centers (MCCs) that have been established under the framework of the UNIMIG Project at three Universities in Armenia, Azerbaijan and Georgia, shall have the possibility to get to know three competence centers at the Karl-Franzens University of Graz during the first two days of the visit. Representatives will explain the working structures, the methodology, the visions etc. of their institutions and will give participants the possibility to learn more about the organization and functioning of such centers of excellence. Importantly, the participants are urged to participate pro-actively in the discussions and use the opportunity to address the speakers and presenters to clarify their questions and concerns and seek advice. The second day will be dedicated to presentations concerning research methods and data analysis both by experts from the Institute of International Law of the University of Graz and the European Training and Research Centre for Human Rights and Democracy.

The last day of the study visit is aimed to introduce the participants into the work of the national IOM office in Vienna. Participants will get an overview over the European Migration Network, its objectives, its methodology and how the structures there could be used as example and be adapted to the MCCs.

How to get from Vienna to Graz?

The most convenient way to get to Graz is by train.

- 1) Take the bus 1187 from Vienna Airport to Wien Meidling (trainstation). The bus leaves every 30 minutes and takes around 20 minutes to get to the train station in Meidling. A one-way ticket costs € 8 a return ticket €13.

- 2) Trains from Wien Meidling to Graz leave basically every hour. When arriving at the train station you can buy the ticket directly at the counter and there is no reservation required. However, you can already buy the tickets in advance online at http://www.oebb.at/en/index.jsp.
 - For the train schedule see Annex II. Please check the screens at the train station for the number of the departure platforms and eventual delays. In case you have questions do not hesitate to ask the people behind the counters they should be able to provide you with information in English.
- 3) When you are arriving at Graz you can take the taxi, walk or take the bus to the hotel which is pretty close to the train station. See the map Annex III.
